The Christmas Box

The Angel of Hope was inspired by Richard Paul Evans' national bestseller, *The Christmas Box*. It is the story of a woman who mourns the loss of her child at the base of an angel monument. The original monument that the partly fictional tale speaks of was destroyed by floods in 1984. Richard Paul Evans commissioned a new Angel in response to reports of parents seeking out the Angel as a place to grieve and heal. That monument now lies in the Salt Lake City Cemetery in Salt Lake City, Utah. It was dedicated on December 6, 1994 - corresponding with the date of the child's death in *The Christmas Box*.

The sculpture is the creation of a father and son from Salt Lake City, Ortho and Jared Fairbanks. It was modeled according to the description in Evans' book. If you look closely, you will find in the Angel's right wing the word "hope."

The Angel of Hope monument provides a spiritual place for parents and families to visit and reflect. It is a place to remember and honor all children no longer with us regardless of age or reason.

May you find healing, peace and comfort in her presence.
